

### Men's Varsity Eight

The Washington-California men's varsity eight dual series dates back to 1903, with 107 meetings between the two schools. At stake is the Schoch Cup, named after Delos Schoch of Washington's class of 1936. Schoch lettered three years (1934-36) as a Husky oarsman. UW currently leads the varsity series 74-32-1.

### Men's Second Varsity (JV) Eight

Washington's junior varsity eight series with California dates back to 1939, with UW winning 50 of 73 races. There were no races between 1943-46. The UW had won seven straight from 2009-15 before Cal won in 2016 and 2017. UW stopped that streak in 2018.

### Men's Freshman Eight

Washington's freshman eight series with California dates back to 1939, with Washington winning 57 of 76 races. There were no races from 1944 through 1946. The Huskies' longest win streak was 15 consecutive from 1966 through 1980.

### Women's Second Varsity (JV) Eight

Washington's junior varsity eight series with California dates back to 1975, with Washington winning 28 of 39 races. There was no JV eight race in 1983 or 1995. Cal won in 2004, snapping an 11-race UW win streak that was the Huskies' longest in the series. Washington has won five of the last six (2013 and 2015-16-17-18), after Cal had won four straight between 2009 and 2012.

### Women's Novice Eight / Third Eight

Washington's novice eight series with California dates back to 1977, with Washington winning 25 of 36 races. The Huskies' longest win streak was 11 straight from 1990-2001. The UW has won 22 of the past 34 races, including that string of 11 straight that Cal halted in 2002. That was Cal's first win since 1989. The novice boats did not race in 1999 but resumed the series in 2000. The Huskies were victorious in 2007, halting a two-year winning streak by the Bears. Cal won in 2015, when the race was held as a third varsity eights event, breaking a two-year win streak by the Huskies. UW came back with a win in 2016, but the Bears won again in 2017. Both a 3V and freshman race were run in 2018.
